**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CENTENARIAN AWARD TO QUALIFIED
CITIZENS IN MARIKINA CITY AND PROVIDING BENEFITS AND FUNDS
THEREFOR**

WHEREAS, Article XV, Section 4 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution declares that it is the duty of the family to take care of its elderly members while the State may design programs of social security for them;

WHEREAS, the city values the contribution of the elders in nation building and they have become building blocks in the city's development;

WHEREAS, this legislative measure recognizes this vital role and the rights of the elderly as well as their continued community involvement being considered integral members of the city;

WHEREAS, it is within the conferred powers of the City Council of Marikina, as provided for in Section 17 of RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to effective and efficient provisions of basic services and facilities as enumerated therein, particularly the establishment of the above program which greatly help to ensure the attainment of integrated services to the elderly;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the CITY COUNCIL OF MARIKINA in session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title.- This Ordinance shall be known as the **Centenarian Award Ordinance in Marikina City**.

SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy.- It is the declared policy of the City Government of Marikina to always recognize and appreciate the vital contribution of the senior citizens particularly the centenarians in nation-building and in their self-sacrificing role in making Marikina City a decent, livable and respectable city.

SECTION 3. Definition of Terms.- As used in this Ordinance, the following words and phrases shall mean as follows:



- a. **Centenarian** refers to a Marikina resident who is one hundred (100) or more years old;
- b. **Elderly** refers to aged, old, advanced years, senior citizens and retired citizens;
- c. **Identification Document** refers to any document or proof of being a senior citizen or centenarian which may be used for the availment of benefits and privileges under this Ordinance; and
- d. **Senior Citizens** refers to any Marikina resident who is sixty (60) years old or above;

SECTION 4. Benefits and Privileges.- This Ordinance will grant the following benefits and privileges to Marikina residents who reach 100 or more years old.

- a. Cash Incentive Ten Thousand Pesos (Php 10,000.00);
- b. Congratulatory Resolution from the City Council and Office of the City Mayor;
- c. Plaque of Recognition
- d. Free Lifetime Membership to Office of Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA)

SECTION 5. To avail of the benefits and privileges as provided for on Section 4 of this Ordinance, the following requirements must be complied with and submitted to the City Social Welfare and Development Office:

- a. The centenarian awardee should be a permanent resident of Marikina City;
- b. The centenarian awardee should be personally present to receive the award to be given by the city officials in a fitting ceremony (except bedridden centenarians because of illness and other analogous reasons)

In any situation mentioned above, the city officials will go to the residence or hospital where the centenarian is to be awarded.

- c. Senior Citizens' Identification Card issued by OSCA;
- d. Other valid documents such as school or employment records, driver's license, birth certificate, baptismal certificate, marriage certificate and other similar government-issued identification documents.

SECTION 6. as the Department of Social Welfare and Development mandates the conduct of "Elderly Filipino Week" on the first week of October, in commemoration of the same, the award to the qualified citizens will be given during the occasion.

SECTION 7. Centenarian Awards Committee. - The following shall be the composite members of the committee who are tasked to evaluate the qualifications of would be-centenarian awardees:

- a. As Chairman: City Council's Committee On Senior Citizens and Persons with Disability
- b. As Members: Chief of City Social Welfare and Development Office, President of OSCA, Chief of City Tourism and Cultural Affairs Office and Chief of City Civil Registrar

SECTION 8. Budgetary Allocations.- The allocation of a regular budget of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (P200,000.00) shall be appropriated for this purpose.

SECTION 9. Implementing Rules and Regulations.- OSCA and the City Legal Office shall promulgate rules and regulations, with the approval of the Office of the City Mayor, as are necessary, for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.

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SECTION 10. *Implementing Agency.* – the Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) shall be in charge for the implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 11. *Separability Clause.* – The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be separable and, if any clause, sentence or provision or section of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances should for any reason be held invalid by a competent court, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or application of the Ordinance.

SECTION 12. *Repealing Clause.*- All local ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof that are inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 13. *Effectivity.*- This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
